3. Overview of the Annotated Use Case Guided Approach. In this paper we introduced a new GUI Testing approach between Model-less and Model-Based testing. The new approach is based on a Test Case Autogeneration process that does not build a complete model of the GUI. The test case generation process described in this paper takes as its starting point the set of use cases (a use case is a sequence of events performed on the GUI; in other words, a use case is a test case) that describe the GUI behavior. From this set, it creates a new set of autogenerated test cases, taking into account the variation points (according to possible different values of widgets) and the validation rules included in the annotations. The resulting set includes all the new autogenerated test cases.
